The Auto Extravaganza will continue Saturday and Sunday in the Elkins City Park from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM. The public is welcome and encouraged to attend. Car Show entry registration will be 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM on Saturday, and 9:00 AM – Noon on Sunday. Registered cars and trucks receive a goody bag, commemorative dash and participation plaque to display, commemorative 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary pin, and will be entered into various prize drawings throughout the weekend. This includes the grand prize drawings for an engine, a transmission, and a wheels and tires package.
